Dear Parents, Caregivers & Friends,

Mid-Year Progress Reports come home today. These are a new template we have developed to meet new MOE requirements. We now report on 5 progress descriptors for reading, writing and maths. These being, EMERGING, DEVELOPING, CONSOLIDATING, PROFICIENT & EXCEEDING. At the mid-year stage, students who are graded at EMERGING or DEVELOPING are not on track to meet curriculum expectations by the end of the year. Students who are graded CONSOLIDATING, PROFICIENT or EXCEEDING are on track. At the end of the year, students need to be PROFICIENT or EXCEEDING to meet expectations. A very helpful handout helping explain this will be included with the report. Like always, please communicate with teachers if you want to discuss anything further.
