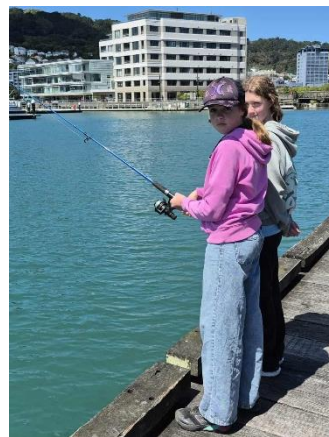
Touch Rugby starts on Monday after school. Please see the attached information with teams. Kate will put the link in an email and on Facebook.
